basic supplies:



materials: paper

- fabric crayons (available in many arts & crafts stores)
- fabric, light blue & tan (synthetic works best)
- iron
- sticks or dowels

teacher preparation:

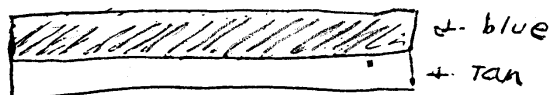
- Sew a flag for each child
- prepare a place to iron (old towel on counter?)
- cut dowel for each child
- cut 5-10 small pieces of paper for each child

procedure:

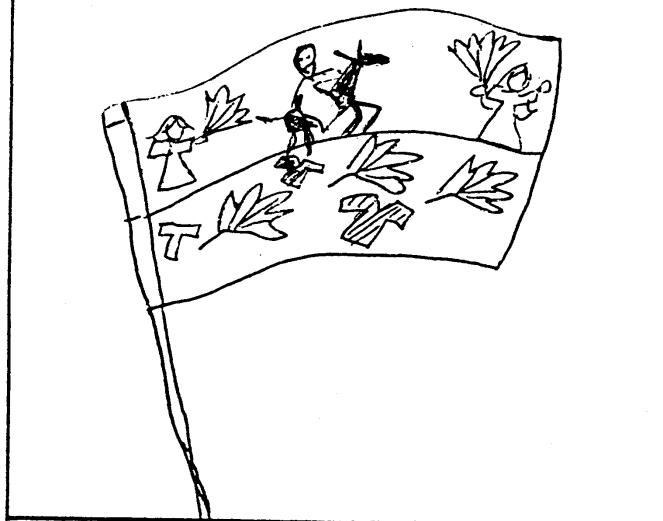
- each child draws with fabric crayons brightly on paper:
  - the LORD on the ass
  - several palms
  - several garments
  - people singing (optional)
- the teacher irons them on the flag
- child puts flag on dowel & waves it! Hosannah!

Make flags:

Sew a strip of blue (sky) to a strip of tan (ground) & cut into as many flag size pieces as you have children



Then sew casings to hold dowels (close at the top so it won't slip)



notes: heat iron a few minutes beforehand  
could simplify by just doing the LORD,  
or just a palm frond...
