basic supplies:



materials: • toy donkey (horse?)

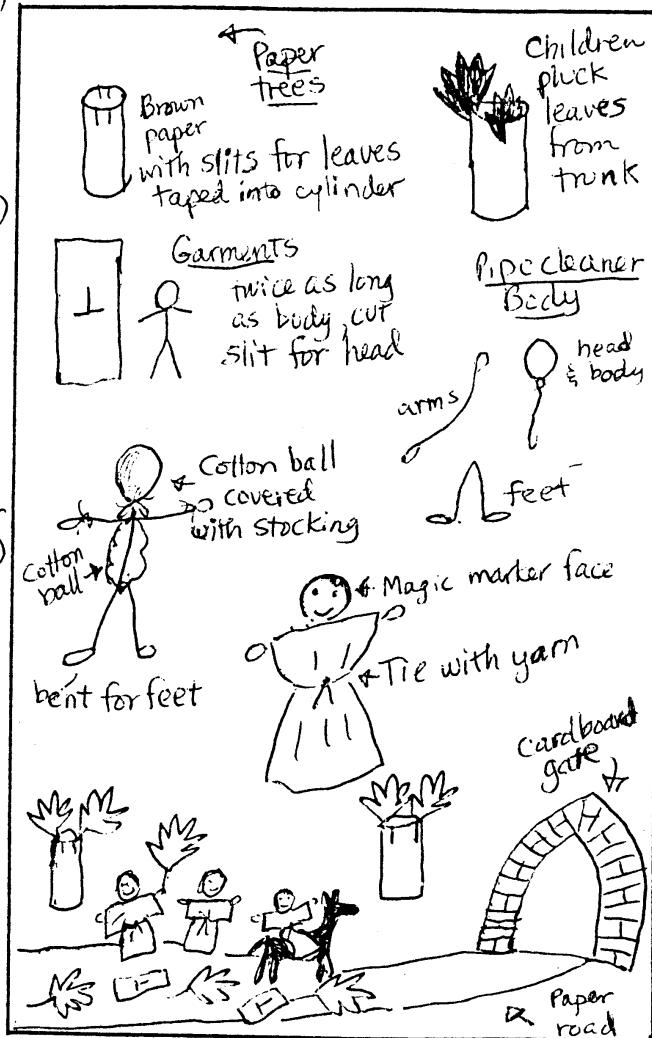
- fabric scraps, old stockings
- pipe cleaners
- cotton balls
- thread
- yarn
- leaves or palms (real or paper)

teacher preparation:

- Make a gate of Jerusalem of paper or cardboard
- Make a paper road
- Make trees (see figure)
- Cut garments of fabric (2 per child)
- Make sample person

procedure:

- Each child makes a person: bend pipecleaners (3 per person) into a body; wrap a cotton ball in the head with a piece of old stocking, tie w/ thread; use a small piece of cotton for each hand & tie a piece of old stocking on each hand; put one or 2 cotton balls around torso & put on garment, tie w/ yarn. using markers, make hair & face
- While singing or reading, each child has their person lay down a palm or garment as the LORD rides into Jerusalem.



notes: They are very cute! This is a more complicated project, but it is special for a special day. It is a group project

MUSIC: first songs: He rode on a donkey

Lori's tape: Hosannah (words are from v. 9)

or use yarn, cut 1/2" pieces, rub between hands to make fuzz, glue on. this looks better
