## basic supplies: MARKERS MARKERS









Materials: rectangular scraps of wood or cardboard; brown paper, red paint or markers.

## teacher preparation:

Collect one scrap of cardboard or wood per child, approximately 6" x 8". Cut a brown paper rectangle for each child that is about 2" shorter and 2" narrower than the wood or cardboard. procedure:

Each child gets rectangle of paper to glue on the wood or cardboard, leaving margins along the top and 2 sides, to be a doortrame. Use red paint or markers to paint "lambs blood "on the door frame. The children who can write letters could write "PASSOVER" on the door.

wood or cardboard

Glue paper door on it, and decorate it to look like a door.

paint "lamb's blood" "2 doorposts on the lintel of the house"

notes: This is a quick project. If you like you could follow it up with a Passover med: unleavened bread, herbs, and bits of roast lamb to taste.
