Subject: Passover

Age Group: Beginners: 3-5

basic supplies:      

Materials: rectangular scraps of wood or cardboard; brown paper, red paint or markers.

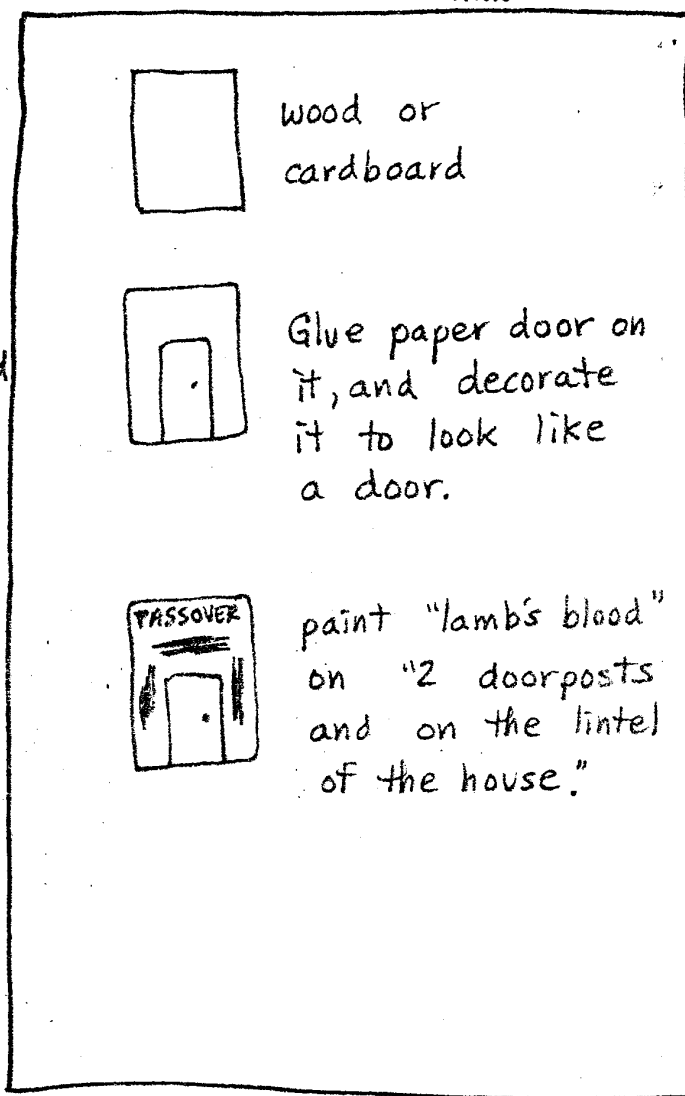
### teacher preparation:

Collect one scrap of cardboard or wood per child, approximately 6" x 8". Cut a brown paper rectangle for each child that is about 2" shorter and 2" narrower than the wood or cardboard.

### procedure:

Each child gets a rectangle of paper to glue on the wood or cardboard, leaving margins along the top and 2 sides, to be a doorframe. Use red paint or markers to paint "lamb's blood" on the doorframe.

The children who can write letters could write "PASSOVER" on the door.



notes: This is a quick project. If you like you could follow it up with a Passover meal: unleavened bread, herbs, and bits of roast lamb to taste.
