

Feeding the Five Thousand

This project simulates a small amount of food being miraculously multiplied by the Lord.

Supplies:

2 printed pages
crayons
scissors
tape

Project instructions:

1. Using crayons or markers, color the picture of Jesus and the basket.
2. Cut along the two dotted lines to make 2 slits in the page.
4. Color the fish and loaves of bread. Cut apart the strips on the dotted lines.
5. Tape the strips together to make one long piece. Put all the fish next to each other with one of the pieces with the two overlapping fish to the far left. Then add all the bread strips.
5. Put each end of the long strip through the slits in the basket from the back, leaving most of the long strip behind the picture. Leave only two fish and five loaves of bread showing on each side of the basket slits.
6. Now you can tell the story of the miracle of the loaves and fish. Pull both ends of the paper strips out to show how a little food was multiplied into much more.
