

PUT THE FLOWER IN THE GARDEN

Play a game that involves not being able to see, such as this variation of Pin-the-tail-on-the-Donkey.

Suggested Materials

large piece of white paper or green poster board flower stickers OR pictures of flowers, cut out (see below) optional: transparent tape for attaching pictures to garden (if not using stickers) scarf or strip of cloth to use as a blindfold

Suggested Procedure

- 1. Attach large piece of paper to a wall or bulletin board within reach of all players.
- 2. Draw a horizontal line across the paper to indicate sky above and garden below the line. Or use green poster board.
- 3. Have each player select a flower sticker or picture.
- 4. When it is his or her turn to put the flower in the garden, tie the scarf or cloth so that the person cannot see. Then guide the player toward the garden and have them try to place it in the garden.

Variation

A more elaborate variation would be to pin animal, plant, and other stickers on a landscape scene to show the things you would miss being able to see if you were blind—even if the dog ends up on top of a tree and a bird is flying in the grass when the game is finished!
