

Abram's Journey

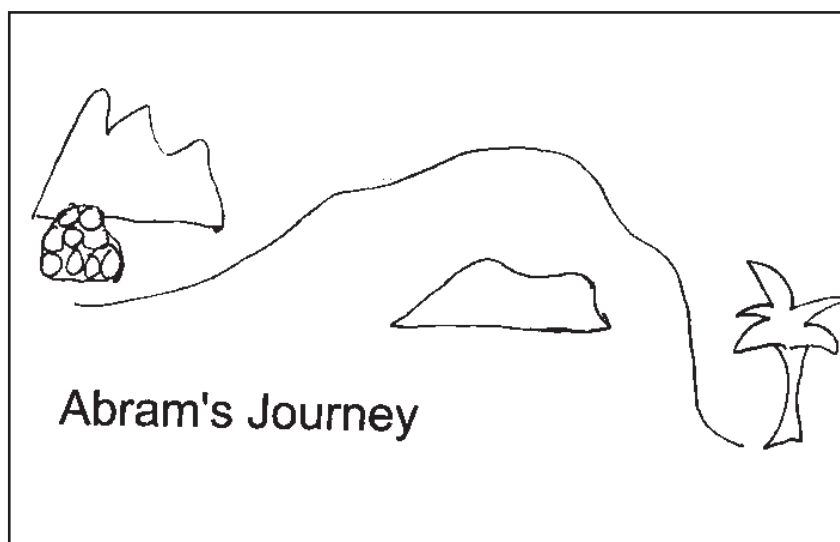
Learn about the land through which Abram walked during his long journey to Canaan.

Supplies:

1 printed page
1 piece of blue paper
crayons or markers
scissors
unsharpened pencil
glue

Project instructions:

1. Color the mountain with 3 peaks purple
2. Color the desert light brown like sand.
3. Color the palm leaves green and the trunk brown.
4. Color the stone altar grey (light black).



5. Color Abram as you wish.
6. Cut out all of the pieces.
7. Glue an unsharpened pencil to the back of the Abram figure.
8. Glue all of the other pieces to the blue paper as shown.
9. Use a black crayon to draw Abram's journey from Ur to Canaan, as shown...
10. Write "Abram's Journey" somewhere on the page.
11. Now you are ready to trace Abram's journey around the desert to the land of Canaan where he built altars and worshiped the Lord.
