Abram's Journey

1 printed page 1 piece of blue paper crayons or markers scissors unsharpened pencil glue

Project instructions:

- Color the mountain with 3 peaks purple
- Color the desert light brown like sand.
- Color the palm leaves green and the trunk brown.
- Color the stone altar grey (light black).
- 5. Color Abram as you wish.
- 6. Cut out all of the pieces.
- 7. Glue an unsharpened pencil to the back of the Abram figure.
- 8. Glue all of the other pieces to the blue paper as shown.
- 9. Use a black crayon to draw Abram's journey from Ur to Canaan, as show ...
- 10. Write "Abram's Journey" somewhere on the page.
- 11. Now you are ready to trace Abram's journey around the desert to the land of Canaan where he built altars and worshiped the Lord.
