

Children Learn in Heaven

This project demonstrates how children in heaven can learn by seeing the flowers in their gardens.

Supplies:

2 printed page
scissors
glue
crayons or markers
several small pieces of different color paper
unsharpened pencil

Project instructions:

1. Cut out the ovals on the printed pages.
2. In the center of one oval, glue a beautiful flower made by cutting various shapes from the pieces of colored paper.
3. In the center of the other oval draw a faded, drooping flower with crayons or markers.
4. Glue the two ovals back to back with the pencil in between, sticking out below the ovals about half way.
5. Now you can turn the oval back and forth while you tell about children in heaven remembering things they have done wrong and then making them right again.
