Children Learn in Heaven

This project demonstrates how children in heaven can learn by seeing the flowers in their gardens.

Supplies:

2 printed page scissors glue crayons or markers several small pieces of different color paper unsharpened pencil

Project instructions:

- 1. Cut out the ovals on the printed pages.
- 2. In the center of one oval, glue a beautiful flower made by cutting various shapes from the pieces of colored paper.
- 3. In the center of the other oval draw a faded, drooping flower with crayons or markers.
- 4. Glue the two ovals back to back with the pencil in between, sticking out below the ovals about half way.
- 5. Now you can turn the oval back and forth while you tell about children in heaven remembering things they have done wrong and then making them right again.
