

Clothespin Figure of Joseph

Genesis 37

Materials needed for each child

a wooden clothespin 6 inch piece of pipe cleaner or wire colored felt tip markers white cloth (or paper) rectangle about 4 by 5 inches yarn, thread or ribbon to tie coat at waist





optional: yarn or fake fur for hair modeling clay or block of Styrofoam to make a stand for Joseph

Procedure

- 1. Wrap about 6" of pipe cleaner around clothespin to make arms. Make loops for hands.
- 2. Use markers to draw a face.
- 3. Make hair with a colored marker. Or glue yarn, felt or fake fur on the "head" of the figure.
- 4. Use markers to decorate the white cloth to make a coat of many colors for Joseph. (Note: Taping the fabric at the top and bottom with masking tape or transparent tape will make it easier to draw the stripes of color on Joseph's beautiful coat.)
- 5. Have an adult fold the cloth in half and cut a small slit for the head, making a small opening in the shape of a diamond to pull over the head. Try to avoid making it too big.)
- 6. Help child put the coat on the clothespin figure and tie at the waist with yarn.
- 7. Make a stand for Joseph with modeling clay or Styrofoam.
