

Family Lesson – The Twelve Apostles (Mark 3) Level 3 – Disciples of the Lord

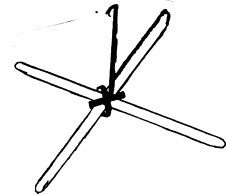
Disciples of the Lord Mobile

You are going to make a mobile of the twelve men who had the privilege of being the Lord's disciples while He was in the world. Later, the twelve became apostles for the Lord, helping to spread the Word. "And they went out and preached everywhere" (Mark 16:20).

We can all be disciples of the Lord if we listen to His teachings and obey His commandments.

Materials needed

- scissors
- string or yarn
- 2 sticks or wooden dowels
- 12 disciple figures (print out attached pages)
- wax crayons, colored markers, or colored pencils
- glue
- optional: clear (transparent) tape



Directions

1. Hold the 2 sticks to make a cross and tied them together in the middle with string or yarn. Leave extra string to hang the mobile from this intersection.

Now you are ready to make the pictures for you mobile!

2. Print the three pages showing the twelve disciples.
3. Color the front and back of each disciple.
4. Cut out the disciples. (Feel free to leave white space around the figures as you cut them out.)
5. Glue the "fronts" to the "backs."
6. Looking at the list of names below, write the name of a disciple on the front or back of a figure. (Make sure you have a figure for each of the twelve names.)

Simon Peter	Philip	James (son of Alphaeus)
James (son of Zebedee)	Bartholomew	Thaddeus
John	Matthew	Simon
Andrew	Thomas	Judas Iscariot

Now you are ready to assemble the mobile.

7. Tape each "apostle" to one end of a piece of string or yarn. (Or punch a small hole to thread the yarn through if you prefer doing it that way.)
8. Tie the other end to the crossed mobile sticks. Repeat until all 12 disciples are part of the mobile. (Note: The pictures will spin if they are hung at different levels.)
