

Illustrate Jehoshaphat and Ahab in Battle

Ahab, king of Israel, said to Jehoshaphat,
“I will disguise myself and go into battle; but you put on your robes.” 1 Kings 22:30

Draw and color either of two pictures on a separate piece of heavy paper:

1. Show King Ahab in his disguise as a common soldier standing next to King Jehoshaphat in his robes.
2. Illustrate the battle scene, with Ahab on one side of the page in his common clothes being struck by an arrow “between the joints of his armor.” You could show Jehoshaphat on the other side, fleeing in his kingly robes. Show lots of action, swords and spears, around them.
