

Make a Model of the Breastplate

The High Priest wore a breastplate on his chest. He used it when he spoke to the Lord. He would ask the Lord a question, and the Lord would answer by flashes of light coming out of the stones. The High Priest knew what each stone meant, so he could read the Lord's answer in the flashing lights. Discover what it looked like by making a model.

Materials Needed

Breastplate Template

stiff gold or yellow paper for printing

scissors

single hole punch

markers or colored pencils

approx. 2' (60cm) yarn or string to wear the finished project

Option: to make the breastplate a little fancier glue colored sequins, glass beads *or* jelly beans on as the breastplate stones

Directions

1. Print the *Breastplate Template* on stiff gold paper.
2. Follow the directions on the template to color the stones the correct color.
3. Cut out the breastplate on the lines.
4. Punch a hole in the two top corners of the breastplate. Thread one end of the yarn or string through each hole and tie a knot to hold in place.
5. Try on the breastplate.
