

Noah's Ark

This project helps children visualize what Noah's ark looked like.

Supplies:

printed page showing the ark
1 piece of sturdy white paper
crayons or markers
scissors
1/2 piece of sturdy blue paper
glue



Project instructions:

1. Color the ark brown since it was made of wood.
2. Carefully cut the solid lines on the windows and fold back the flaps along the dotted lines.
3. Glue the ark page onto the white construction paper, being careful not to get glue near the windows.
4. Using crayons or markers, draw Noah and his wife looking out of the small top window on the white paper. Then draw some animals that will show when the large window opens.
5. Tear the blue paper in random shapes, and glue them at the bottom of the boat to show the water.
