## Noah's Rainbow Project

Create a rainbow out of tissue to celebrate the Lord's covenant with Noah.

## Supplies needed

- copy of rainbow page
- 1 piece blue stiff paper (such as construction paper)
- 6 pieces of tissue paper in rainbow colors approx. 15"x 20" (135cm x 150cm)
- scissors
- glue
- paintbrush for gluing

## **Directions**

- 1. Cut out Noah's Rainbow and glue it to a larger piece of sturdy blue paper.
- 2. Cut the red tissue into small pieces, approx.  $2'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$  (5cm × 6.5cm).
- 3. Using the paintbrush, put glue on the space of the uppermost strip of the rainbow. Crumple up one piece of red tissue paper at a time and poke it on to the wet glue. Continue across the rainbow shape.
- 4. Cut the orange tissue paper into small pieces. Glue them to the next strip on the rainbow.
- 5. Continue cutting the tissue paper and gluing all the colors until you have finished the rainbow. Be sure to follow the order of the colors in a real rainbow: red, orange, yellow, green, blue and purple.
- 6. Add the title "Noah's Rainbow" if you wish.
- 7. What did the sign of the rainbow mean to Noah and his family?
