## **Prophecies of the Lord's Birth Mobile**

- 1. Print a copy of the Star Template (see next page) page on stiff paper of your choice.
- 2. Cut out at least five stars.
- 3. Write one of the prophecies given below on each star. Write the chapter and verse of the prophecy on the back.
- 4. Punch a hole in the top of each star. *Optional*: put glitter around the edges of the stars, if you wish.
- 5. Tie two sticks together in the middle to form a cross. Tie a string to the center where they cross to hang the mobile.
- 6. Put strings in the holes in the stars and hang them on the sticks with the star quote somewhere prominent—maybe in the center on the string holding the mobile. Adjust the stars for balance.
