

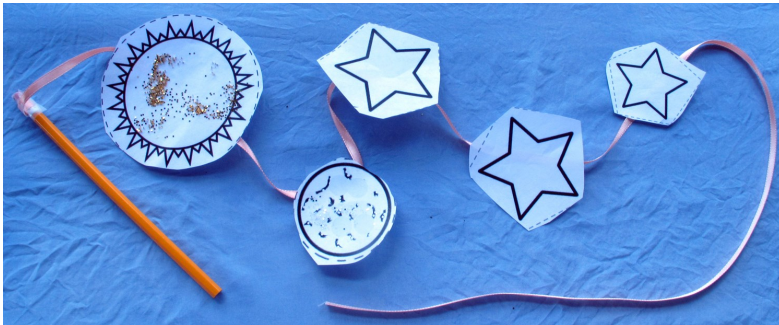

Choice

Sun, Moon and Stars Streamer

The Lord gives us warmth and light by means of the sun, moon and stars. Create a streamer showing the sun, moon and stars. When the projects are finished, stand up and hold streamers high. Follow the leader and have a parade! See the sun, moon and stars trail across the “sky” behind each child.

1. Set up the supplies so that each child has what he or she needs within easy reach. Each child needs a sun, moon and 3 stars, ribbon or yarn, glue and glitter.
2. Cut out the sun, moon and stars. *Note:* cutting approximate shapes is fine.
3. Spread glue on one side of the sun. Sprinkle with gold glitter.
4. Spread glue on one side of the moon. Sprinkle with silver glitter.
5. Spread glue on one side of each star. Sprinkle with your choice of gold or silver glitter (since they are distant suns).
6. Lay the sun, moon and stars over the ribbon or yarn attached to the pencil, spacing them evenly. Tape the back side of each piece to the yarn or string.
7. Stand in line. Holding on to the pencil, raise hands to the sky. Walk in a line and have a parade—around the room, through the hallway, or even outside!



Materials for Each Child

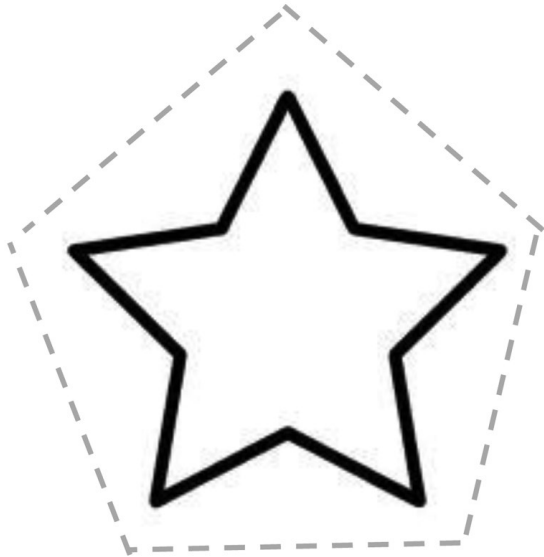
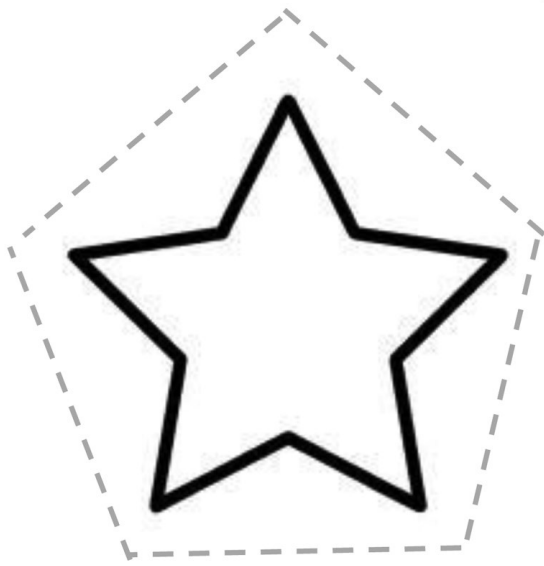
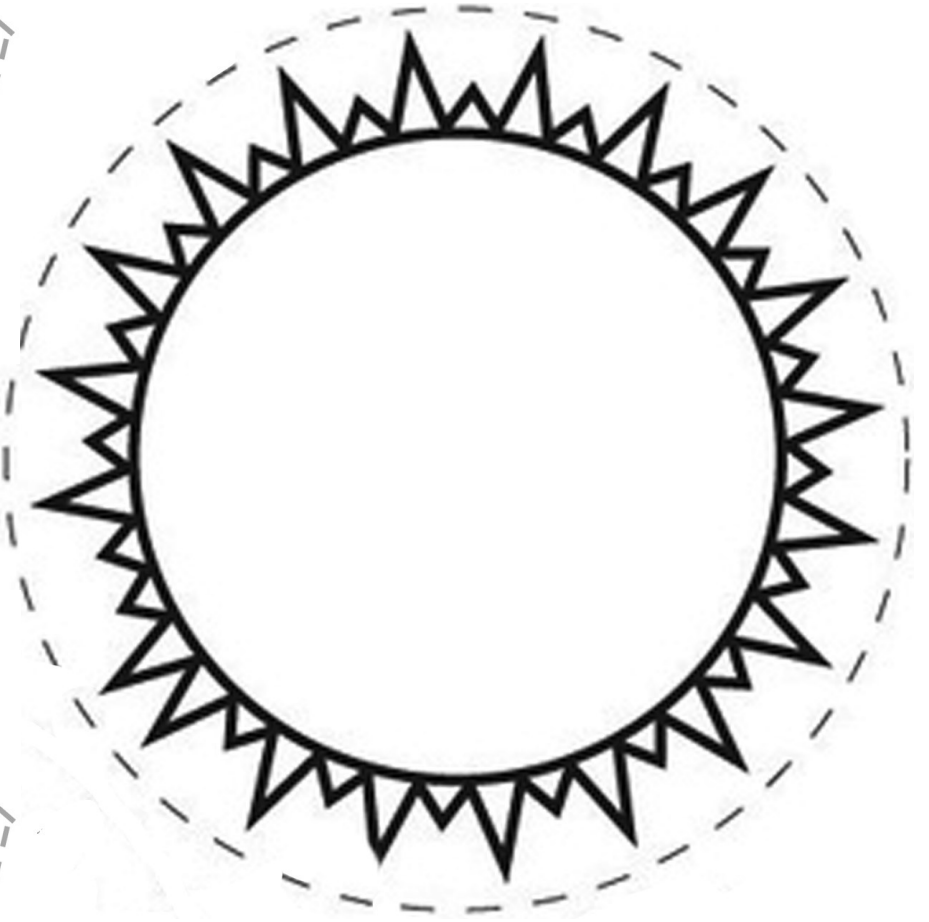
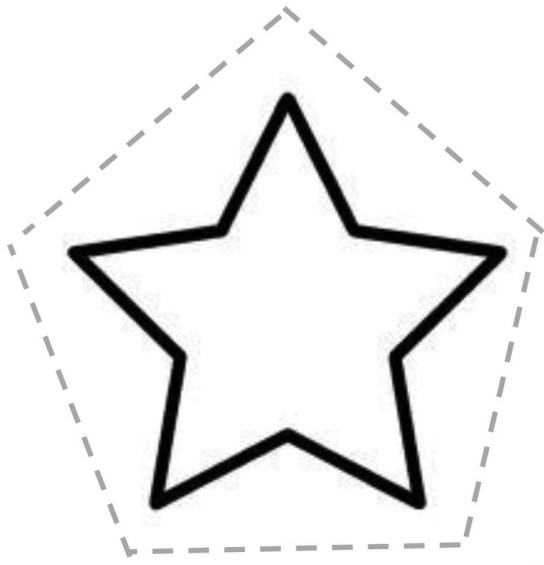
Sun, Moon and Stars p. 2 printed on yellow paper, scissors, glue, gold and silver glitter, piece of yarn or ribbon approx. 36” (90cm) long, new unsharpened pencil, tape

Prepare in Advance

Tape or tie the yarn or ribbon to the pencils. For younger children, cut out the sun, moon and stars.

Easy Glitter Cleanup

Sprinkle glitter over a baking tray to catch spills. Tip the glitter into a corner of the tray and pour back into the container when done.
