

Thanksgiving | Good Neighbor Mobile

The New Church teaches that we have various kinds of neighbors. We can be neighbors to our family, our community, our country, the human race, the church, to heaven and to the Lord. Create a mobile illustrating the various kinds of neighbors we have.

Materials

crayons, colored pencils or markers

Good Neighbor Mobile Templates printed on stiff or regular paper

wire coat hanger or rod suitable for hanging the mobile

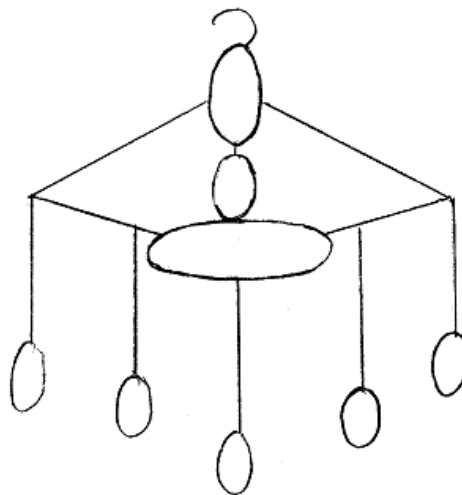
scissors

yarn or string

tape

Directions

1. Using the *Good Neighbor Mobile Templates*, draw pictures of our neighbors in the ovals using crayons, colored pencils or markers.
2. Cut out all of the finished pictures.
3. Attach the pictures to a wire coat hanger or other hanger as shown below.
4. Use tape to attach the Lord near the top of the mobile. Attach “Heaven” right below it. Attach “I am a good neighbor...” to the bottom of the hanger. Tape yarn or string to the back of the remaining pieces and tie to the hanger. You may need to bend the hanger in order to fit all of the pieces.
