Family Lesson – The Twelve Apostles (Mark 3) Level 2 – The Lord and His Apostles

The Lord and His Apostles




Today we are going to make a picture of the Lord and His disciples. The Lord went up to the top of the mountain and called twelve disciples to be with Him. The Lord taught them, and they saw Him do many wonderful things. He was preparing them to be apostles who would go out to teach other people and heal them.

Materials needed

large white paper (9" by 15" suggested) colored paper to mount the drawing (11" by 17" suggested) wax crayons (or colored markers)

Directions

- 1. Have each child draw a tall mountain with the Lord standing at the top. The figure of the Lord might be almost entirely shining light, created by strokes of yellow crayon radiating in all directions.
- 2. Then have the child choose twelve different crayon colors, one for each disciple, and draw the figures on the mountain. Remember, the figures may be mere scribbles, but in the child's eyes they will look fine.
- 3. Mount the picture on the enclosed 11" x 17" paper and display somewhere.
