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Text: Exodus 16

Subject: Quails and Manna

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Age Group: Beginners: 3-5

basic supplies:



Materials:

- a loaf of bread
- honey
- a hanger for each child
- yarn
- paper
- feathers

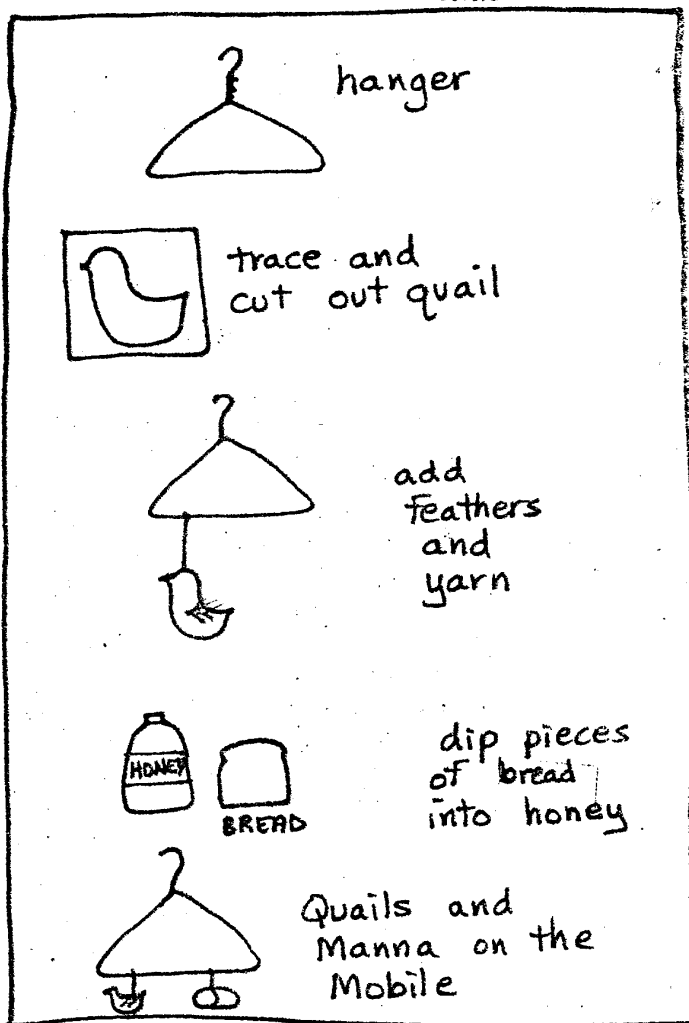
teacher preparation:

- cut bread into bite-sized pieces
- cut yarn into lengths about 12" long - need 2 per child, at least
- make a simple cardboard shape - like a quail.



procedure:

- To make a quail to hang on the mobile, trace around bird onto paper. Cut it out and glue a few feathers on both sides. Tape a string of yarn to quail and tie onto hanger, for a mobile.
- To make manna, which is like sweet bread, dip a piece of bread into honey a tie yarn around it. Tie other end to hanger, for the mobile.
- Let children eat a few "manna", and discuss how the Children of Israel thought it was delicious!



notes: Hang the mobiles high, so you can look up and see quails and manna coming down from heaven.
