

The Lord Is My Shepherd Book Mark

Materials:

2 pieces of light blue or green satin ribbon (1.5 inches wide), cut 12 inches long

Embroidery thread (white, brown or black, and the color of your choice for the lettering).

Embroidery needle



The Lord is my Shepherd.



Procedure:

1. Choose embroidery thread for the lettering. It should be a color that you like and that will show up well against the color of the ribbon. Use 2 strands of the thread to embroider the lettering with outline stitch or stem stitch.
2. Use white embroidery thread for the lamb. You may embroider all of the lamb with a satin stitch or split stitch. Or just outline it.
3. Use brown or black thread for the shepherd's staff which symbolizes the Lord's Word guiding us in life.
4. Use straight pins to fasten the 2 ribbons together, shiny side out. Then whipstitch them together through the ribbon bindings (at the edges).
5. Leave 1/2 inch free at both ends of the ribbon if you want to fringe the ends. Otherwise, turn the ends under and whipstitch closed.
