basic supplies:



materials: smocks, newspaper

- potatoes, styrofoam or rubber tiles
- large sheet of paper (butcher, newsprint)
- paint, brushes
- instruments to cut potatoes, styrofoam or rubber tiles (knives, wood carving tools..)

teacher preparation:

- cut out a man to demonstrate printing for children (also to try out instruments)
- using brushes, paint the cut out figure and print on the large paper
- put paper on newspapers on a large surface (floor or table)

procedure:

- each child cuts out one figure from potato etc. of either fighting soldier, fallen soldier, fleeing soldier or part of the landscape
- print a cooperative mural of Jonathan and his armorbearer conquering the Philistines
- print Jonathan and his armorbearer in the center, perhaps a special color
