SHEEPFOLD COLLAGE



Motivation

The sheepfold is a protected place for the sheep to gather at night. A shepherd counts the sheep when they enter the sheepfold to make sure that all the sheep are safe within. Can you make a picture of the Lord standing at the door of the sheepfold as His sheep come in?

Materials

sheet of blue construction paper small piece of brown paper for the door of the sheepfold cotton balls for sheep crayons or markers for drawing and coloring details glue for the cotton sheep and the door

Procedure

- 1. Draw the fence or wall of the sheepfold, leaving space for the door.
- 2. Cut the door (or gate) out of the brown paper so that it fits the opening.
- 3. Glue the door to the paper along *one side* so that the door will open and close (as if on a hinge).
- 4. Draw a picture of the Lord as the Good Shepherd standing by the door.
- 5. Glue cotton balls to the paper to make the sheep, then use crayons or markers to add their heads, tails, and feet.
