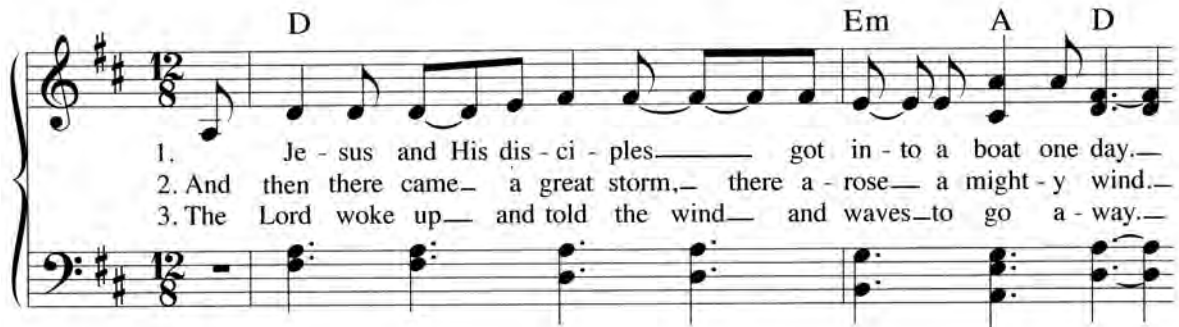


The Storm

Em A D



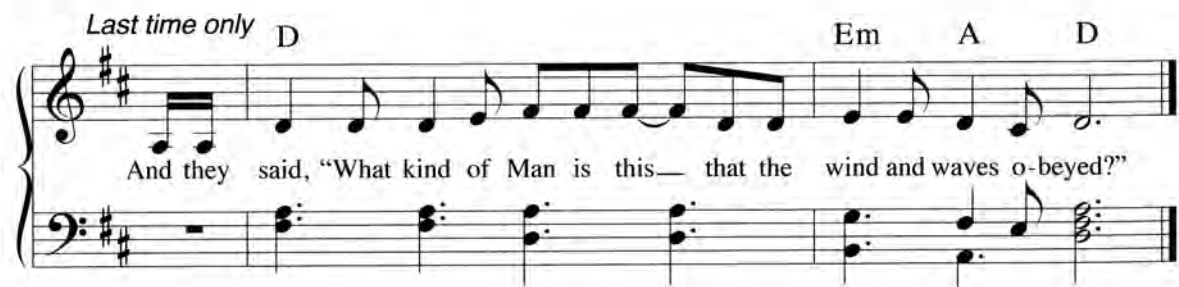
They want - ed to go to the oth - er side, — so they start - ed to sail a - way. —
