

Joseph's Cup Found

Level B

Ages 7-10

Genesis 43:1-5, 11-13, 15-17, 26-34; 44: 1-7, 12-14

Life Focus: The Lord sees everything I do.

Memory Verse: [The steward] searched...and the cup was

found in Benjamin's sack. Genesis 44:12

Story Summary: The famine continued, and Jacob and his family needed more grain. Judah reminded Jacob that Benjamin had to go to Egypt with them and took responsibility for his safekeeping. They returned to Egypt with gifts and double the money they needed. Joseph saw them and prepared a feast for them. The frightened brothers told the steward about the money in their sacks, and learned that there was no problem. The brothers bowed to Joseph when he arrived. Overcome by seeing Benjamin, Joseph wept. The brothers were seated by age at the feast, and Benjamin was served five times more food than anyone else. The next morning Joseph instructed that his cup should be secretly put in Benjamin's sack along with the grain. Shortly after the brothers left, Joseph's steward went after them and found the cup. The brothers returned to Joseph, bowing to the ground.

1. Getting Started

Welcome Warm-up Activity

The 12 Sons of Jacob song

Memorize the names of the brothers in Joseph's family by singing The 12 Sons of Jacob by Lori Odhner. An online, sing-along video is available at www.bitly.com/The12SonsOfJacob. See p. 4 for instructions on how to download the song to your computer or other listening device.

Listen through the song several times and then sing along. *Optional*: make learning fun by joining hands and singing as you walk in a circle. As the song finishes, turn in the opposite direction and sing again.

2. Focus on the Word

Read Genesis 43:1-5, 11-13, 15-17, 26-34; 44:1-7, 12-14

Show the **teaching pictures** on pp. 71-73 as you discuss the story.

Talk About It

Joseph's family had run out of food since their last visit to Egypt. Imagine if your parents stopped going to the store to buy food. How long do you think it would take before your family ran out of food? What would dinner time be like?

Jacob decided to send his sons to Egypt for more food. He had waited a long time. He did not want to send Benjamin because he was worried that something might happen to him. The brothers knew that Benjamin had to go because Joseph had said he would not see them unless Benjamin was with them. Joseph had kept Simeon as a prisoner and would not release him until Benjamin came. Have you ever been worried about something you had to do? What was it like?

What did Joseph do when he saw Benjamin? He cried. People sometimes cry when they are happy—as well as when they are sad. People can also cry when something happens that they hoped for but doubted would ever occur. Joseph cried because he was so happy to see his younger brother.

Joseph made a big feast for his brothers at his own house. How did he seat the brothers around the table? From oldest to youngest. This must have been a big surprise—how could a stranger have known their ages?

What did Joseph's steward hide in Benjamin's sack? Joseph's cup.

Who discovered the cup? Joseph sent his steward after his brothers soon after they had left and asked them why they had repaid evil for good by stealing the cup. The brothers said they had not taken the cup and quickly opened their sacks. The steward looked in all of the sacks from oldest to youngest before finding it in Benjamin's sack.

What did the brothers do to show their sadness? They tore their clothes—which was usually a sign that somebody had died. What do you do when you are sad?

Had Joseph's brothers done anything wrong? They did not take the cup, but they remembered treating Joseph badly a long time before and thought they were being punished for that.

The Lord knows everything we do, and He knows what is in our heart. If we make a mistake we can pray to the Lord. He will help us to be sorry so that we can try to do better the next time. This is how the Lord helps us get to heaven!

3. Learn by Doing

Choose one or two activities



A Cup for Joseph

Make a special cup like Joseph's. Joseph's silver cup represents true ideas from the Lord's Word. Just as Joseph put his cup into Benjamin's sack, the Lord plants true ideas in our minds as we read His Word. Choose from 3 options to make a cup.

Glitter Note: It is likely that children will want to "drink" from their finished cups. Avoid using tape, glue and glitter close to the top of the cup to prevent children from accidentally getting glitter in their mouths.

Handmade Paper Cup (See video demonstration online.)

- 1. Give each child a piece of paper, approx. 8 1/2 x 11 in (22 x 28 cm). Show the children how to overlap the ends of the longer sides of the paper to form a tube. Secure the tube using pre-cut tape.
- 2. Scrunch the paper into a goblet "stem".
- 3. **Teacher** slits the scrunched end, pushes slit end through the hole in the base, spreads out the slit ends to balance the cup and tapes in place.
- 4. Decorate the cup with glue and silver glitter. *Optional*: glue on fake gems.

Plastic Wineglass

- 1. **Before class**: Stick double-sided tape in a circle around the cup, avoiding the top. Set up a glitter tray.
- 2. **During class**: give each child a taped cup. Sprinkle silver glitter on the tape over a glitter tray.
- 3. Give each child a piece of aluminum foil to wrap around the base.

Decorated Paper or Plastic Cup

- 1. **Before class**: Stick double-sided tape in a circle around the cup, avoiding the top. Set up a glitter tray.
- 2. **During class**: give each child a taped cup. Sprinkle silver glitter on the tape over a glitter tray.
- 3. Decorate the cup with stickers.



Choice **₹** Brothers Bingo!

Learn the names of Joseph's brothers and associate each name with its symbolic meaning by playing Brothers Bingo!

- 1. Give each child a *Brothers Bingo Board* and enough coins, poker chips, etc. to cover squares that have been called. Or give children pens or pencils to mark off the squares. *Optional*: make the game more interesting in a small group by giving each child two boards to complete simultaneously!
- 2. Start by placing a marker on the center square.
- 3. Shuffle the *Brothers Bingo Name Cards* and call the cards one by one. When you have finished going through the cards, shuffle and read again.
- 4. The player who places five markers in a row—vertically, horizontally or diagonally wins!
- 5. If there is interest, replay!



Materials for Each Child

sheet of paper, 1 copy of Cup Base (p. 74), tape, glue, silver glitter, scissors for the teacher *Optional*: fake "gemstones", cardboard to stabilize the base.

Do in Advance

Cut out base *optional*: glue on thin cardboard (e.g. cereal box), cut hole in center, cut tape pieces and stick to edge of table, set up glitter tray

Plastic Wineglass: plastic cup with stem, double sided tape, silver glitter, piece of aluminum foil large enough to cover stem

Decorated Paper or Plastic-

Cup: paper cup, double-sided tape, silver glitter, stickers. *Optional:* plastic "gemstones", sequins, glue. **Do in Advance**: stick double-sided tape in a circle around the cup.

Materials

Brothers Bingo Name Cards pp. 75-76, different Brothers Bingo Boards pp. 77-86 for each child, enough coins, poker chips, tiddlywinks, or stickers to cover squares that have been called or pens or pencils to mark off spaces (Note: boards cannot be re-used if marked in this way)

Picture to Color: Joseph's Cup Is Found in Benjamin's Sack

Hand out copies of the picture and invite the children to color it.

4. Wrap It Up

Read the *Memory Verse* aloud. Repeat it slowly several times. Invite the children to say it with you.


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
