New Church Video-Enhanced Lessons for Teens

Year 3 of *FaithBuilder* is a study of the Gospel of John. It is a shortened version of the Academy of the New Church Schools' Grade 9 religion curriculum. The first six lessons review the storyline of the Old Testament, set the cultural and political scene for Jesus' life, and examine differences between the Gospel of John and the Synoptic gospels (Matthew, Mark and Luke). These introductory lessons are more information oriented than other lessons in the *FaithBuilder* series. The Gospel itself is taught through *The Life of Jesus*, a video that is an accurate rendering of the Gospel of John, and discussion.

These lessons may be used by single or multi-aged teen groups. Each lesson provides discussion questions on a variety of levels. Simply pick and choose questions that are right for your group. For single-aged groups, we suggest the following: Year 1 (12-13yrs), Year 2 (13-14yrs), Year 3 (14-15yrs), Year 4 (15-16yrs).

Each lesson takes approximately 20-30 minutes to complete. Lessons include teacher background and are in easy-to-use printer to classroom format. They do not require additional supplies. We recommend reading through all parts of a lesson prior to teaching so lessons flow quickly when choices are provided.

Internet access is required for all online videos. Easy-use bitly links take you directly to the video content. *Important note: bitly links must be entered in the web browser bar at the top of your screen. Links will not work if entered in the search bar in the middle of your screen.* Links are case and space sensitive! Full video titles and timings are provided in case you have difficulty getting links to work. Some recommended videos are provided by YouTube channels over which GCED has no control. If you are planning lessons for the year you may need to change the order of numbered lessons to accommodate the holiday calendar. Typically, Christmas lessons are taught during the first two weeks in December, Easter lessons are taught two weeks prior to Easter, New Church Day is taught in early June, and Emanuel Swedenborg's life is taught close to his birthday, January 29 (1688).
