Teacher Preparation

Introduction

Welcome the kids and ask them how they're doing.

Read and Discuss




- Read *Exodus 12:1-12* about the Passover, and then read *Matthew 26:17-29* about the Last Supper. Have the kids note similarities and differences. Then tell them about Holy Supper, and how we do it. Discuss with them why the Jews celebrated (and still do!) Passover and why we celebrate the Holy Supper.
 - Jews celebrate Passover to remind them that the Lords saved them from slavery in Egypt.
 - Christians celebrate with the Holy Supper (called Communion in other churches) to remind us of our deal with the Lord—we do our best to follow Him, and He will help us get to Heaven.

Activities and Project

- Each student will fill out the sheet comparing the Passover, the Last Supper and Holy Supper. If there is time, colour the pictures.
