TELL THE CHRISTMAS STORY WITH MOVING PICTURES

A moving picture of a story from the Word.

Materials: Shoe Box

2 – 1" dowels roll of shelf paper

crayons glue

Construction:

- 1. Cut a three or four inch square in the bottom of the shoe box. Also cut 2 1" holes on the sides of the box, near the bottom on each side of the square (for the Picture Screen).
- 2. Cut the shelf roll a little less wide than the bottom of the shoe box.
- 3. Mark off picture squares the same size as the square hole in the shoe box.
- 4. Choose a story from the Word to tell in a picture sequence. Color and print picture titles if desired.
- 5. Glue the ends of the finished roll on each dowel, after they have been placed in the holes in the shoe box.
- 6. Turn the roll from right to left as you tell the story.

If you leave long blank "ends" on each picture roll you could use the same construction for several different "moving pictures"
