basic supplies:



materials:


stapler or tape
cardboard
paper

teacher preparation:

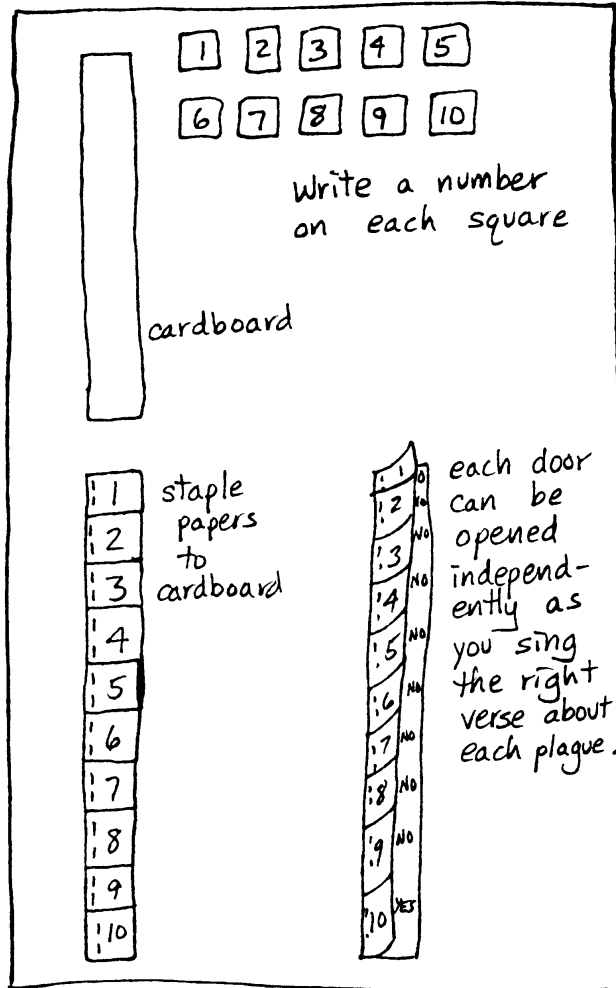
Cut out for each child:
1: 3" x 30" strip of cardboard

10: 3" x 3" squares of paper

procedure:

Have each child write a number on each of their paper squares, from 1 to 10. (Put dots  for them to follow if they can't do it themselves.)

Each plague can be illustrated next to the appropriate number if time allows, and if the children want to do it. Line up the paper squares in sequence and staple along one side to the cardboard strip. Each square becomes a door. Behind doors 1-9, write NO; behind door 10 write YES



notes: If the children can draw letters and numbers, let them do it here. If not, they can illustrate each square with their version of blood, frogs, etc.
