materials:

- white paper, markers

- OPTIONAL {
- cardboard
 - glue
 - large needles & strong thread
 - fabric (wool would be special!)
 - scissors

teacher preparation:

- decide if you want to use your time for binding a book that can be written in over several weeks (perhaps coordinate with other s.s. teachers) or if you want to concentrate on just innocence ~ lambs and omit the binding
- learn all you can about lambs & their correspondence ~ Language of Parable is a good resource, or ask a minister

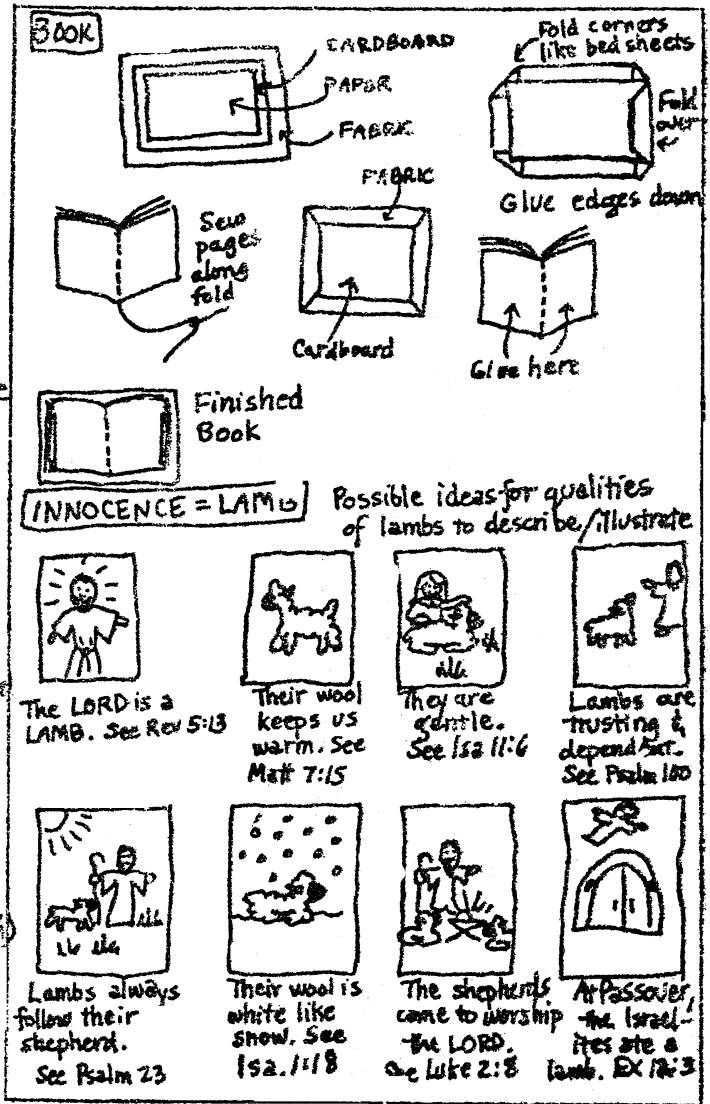
FOR BOOK: [cut cardboard 1/2" bigger around than paper, and fabric 4" bigger around than cardboard]

procedure:

- FOR BOOK:
- lay cardboard on chosen fabric, fold up edges & glue down neatly
 - using as many pages* as you want, fold in half and sew down that line with needle & thread (running stitch)
 - glue pages to inside cover by spreading glue on outer page

CORRESPONDENCES - Talk about how we can be like lambs ~ innocent, trusting, following the LORD, coming to worship Him, pure & white, warm & loving etc.
