

basic supplies:













materials:

·lots of posterboard; red, white etc (a paper plats) (or construction paper and cordboard)

brass fasteners

· something sharp to pole holes, hole punch

teacher preparation:

· Cut out circles from posterboard or cardboard covered with construction paper (large is nice about 184) I perchild

· Poke holes in centers

Make sample

· Could draw the ark and word for them to cut out, if they are not able to easily

procedure:

Cut out on ark and the WORD of paskerboard or construction paper

·Punch holes in them


. With faskner ottotch ark to one side and USED to the other through hole in center of large circle
