Subject: The Ark Brought to Jerusalem

basic supplies:



materials: lots of "junk": plasticene,

- boxes, lids of cans, wire, popsicle sticks, thread spools, dowels, little wheels, nails, wood scraps, cardboard, string, clothespins, fabric scraps, pipe cleaners, yarn scraps, cotton
- paint (including gold for the ark)
- glue, tape, stapler, scissors, colored paper

teacher preparation:

- set up the landscape for a diorama, the hill and road leading to Jerusalem (use sand, green and brown fabric or paper,)

procedure:

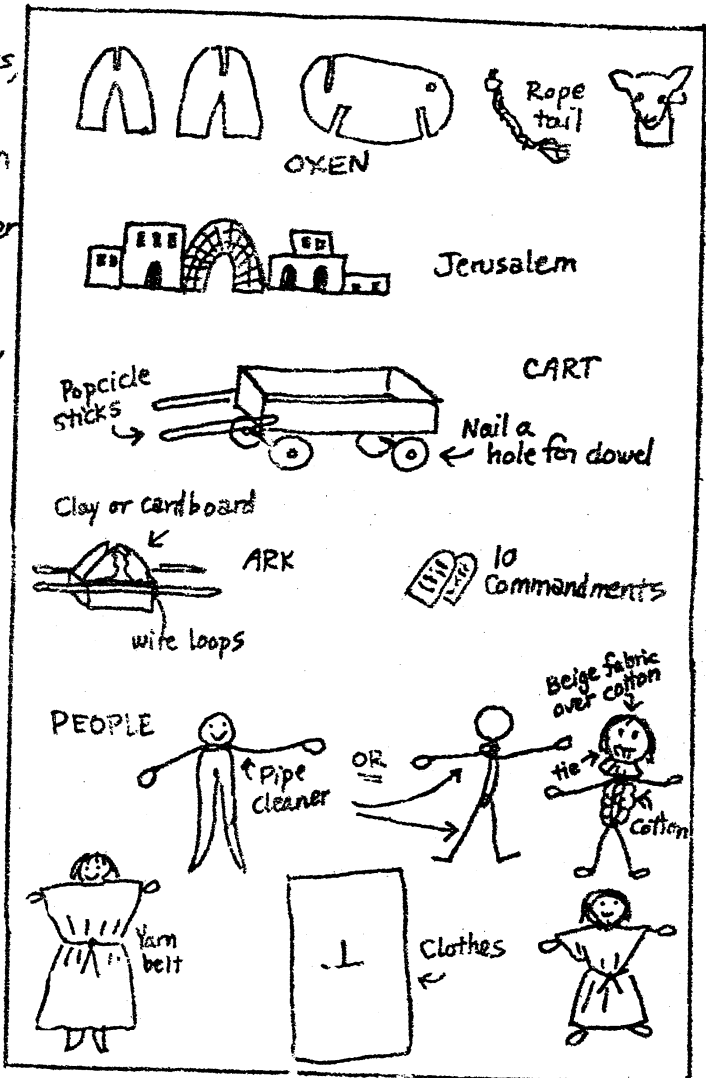
- each child (or pair of children) choose a part of the story to build out of whatever materials inspire them

IDEAS - the cattle pulling the wagon can be made by slotting cardboard pieces together and painting (braid a tail)

- Jerusalem can be made of boxes, taped and glued together, on top of the hill (painted or covered w/paper)
- the cart can be made of a box, and lids, and dowels for axels, spools for wheels

- the ark can be made of a box, and cardboard chenabim, dowels for poles.

- 10 Commandments can be plasticene
- Uzzah and priests & David can be pipe cleaners or clothespins clotted in fabric scraps and yarn with painted faces
