basic supplies:



materials:

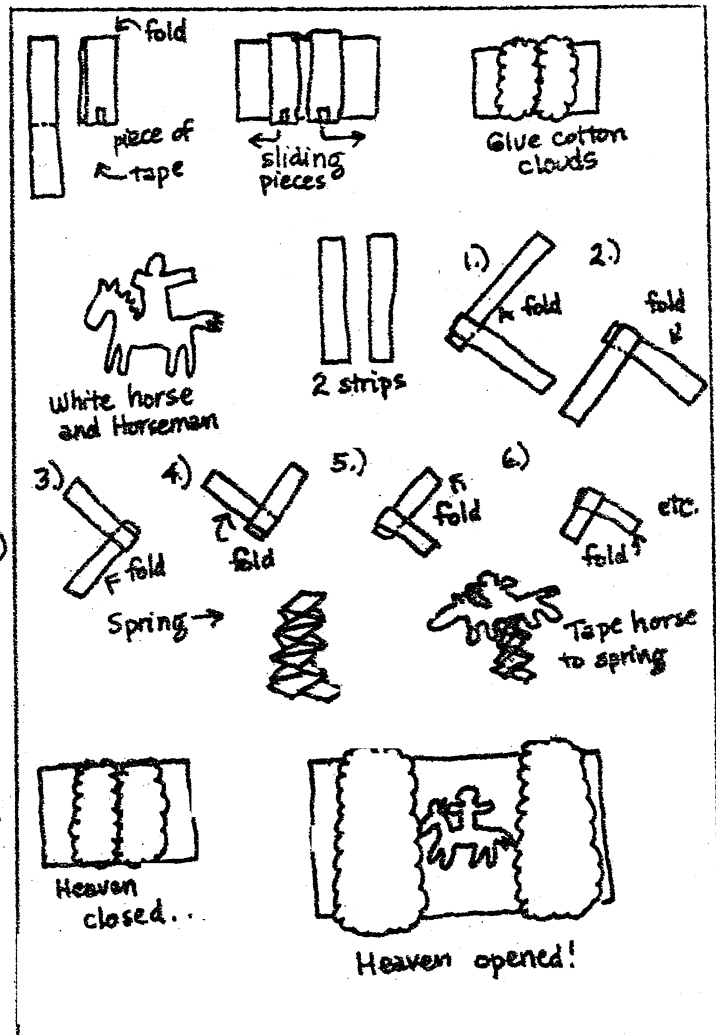
- light blue construction paper
- cotton balls or batting
- scissors, tape, glue
- white construction paper
- pencils

teacher preparation:

- if desired, make a horseman pattern for children to trace, or draw for them to cut out
- make sample
- cut blue paper: one 5" x 11" and two 3 1/2" x 11" pieces per child (approx.)
- cut white strips approx. 6" x 1" (2 per child)

procedure:

- fold the 2-3 1/2" wide blue pieces in half and tape into a loop
- insert the 5" wide blue piece so that the thinner ones can slide back and forth along the wide one
- glue cotton on these 2 sliding pieces to represent heaven
- cut out horseman (draw first, if teacher hasn't done so) of white
- fold the 2 white strips back and forth over each other to make a little "spring"
- tape or glue one end of spring to horse, and the other end to the middle of the 5" piece of blue paper
- when clouds slide back white horse jumps out



notes: you can simplify by using just one folded strip spring, or 2 separate ones
