Subject: The Capture and Return of the Ark

basic supplies:



materials: pictures of the ark

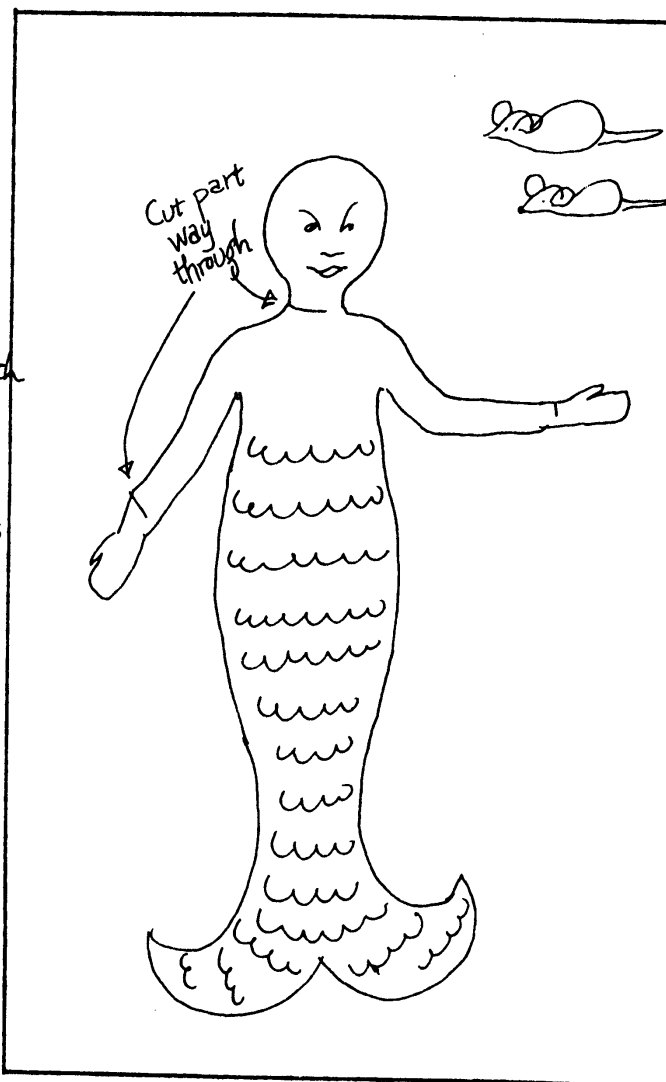
- Cornstarch clay
- either food coloring or paint & brushes
- gold spray paint
- newspaper
- smocks

teacher preparation:

- Make cornstarch clay: 2 parts salt
(either add food coloring to clay or paint later) 1 part cornstarch
1 part water
— Mix & cook over low heat until stiff
- Make sample Dagon and let dry 2 days
- Cut Dagon's head and wrists partway through

procedure:

- Make Dagon
- Make mice
- paint Dagon's if necessary, let dry 2 days
- Spray mice gold
- Since theirs are not dry yet, demonstrate with sample how he fell and broke before the ark



notes: if short of time, omit mice
• could toast in toaster oven if preferred
