Subject: The Choosing of Saul

Age Group: Primary: 6-8

basic supplies:      

materials: empty juice cans (one taller than the rest)

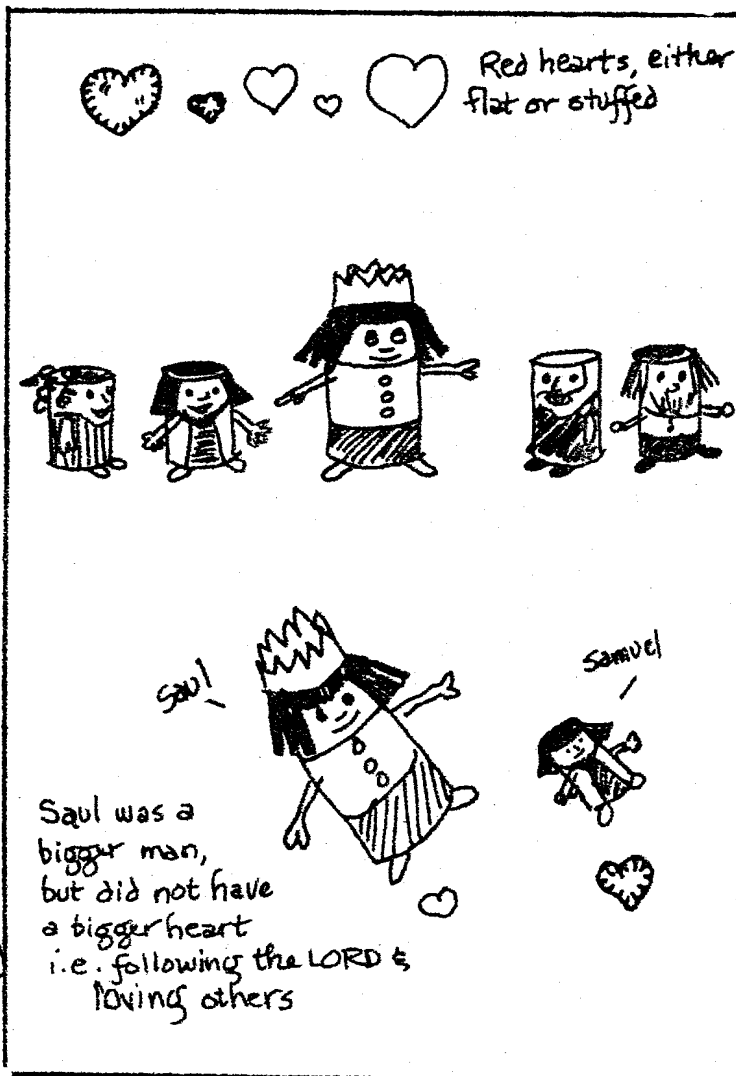
- colored paper
- glue, scissors
- red felt
- stuffing, needle & thread (optional)

teacher preparation:

- Make sample
- Make different sizes of red hearts, either a single layer of felt, or 2 layers, stuffed & blanket stitched around

procedure: choose one child to make Saul, perhaps by lot so they understand this aspect of the story (the tall can)

- each child decorates a juice can to look like an Israelite.
- you could have fun naming them as characters from the story
- put hearts under each can (in secret), placing a smaller heart under the tall Saul can
- have the children try to guess who has bigger hearts, discussing appearances, inside vs. outside etc.
