

The Eyes of the Blind Shall See Him

The Lord healed many people, including those who were blind and could not see. He can heal each one of us of spiritual blindness which is being ignorant about what is true. This project illustrates this idea with a picture of the Lord in heaven that can be revealed or uncovered when our "blindness" is healed.

Suggested Materials

2 pieces of paper OR 1 piece of paper and 1 piece of fabric (same size as paper)
wax crayons, colored pencils, oil pastels or colored markers
tape or stapler (to fasten the drawing and covering piece together)
text slip to glue at the bottom of the picture
glue

Suggested Procedure

1. Make a picture of the Lord in heaven with bright light all around Him.
2. Cover the picture with fabric or another piece of paper, attaching it only at the top edge (with tape or staples) so it can be lifted up to see the picture of the Lord.
3. Glue the text slip with the quote from the Word at the bottom of the covering piece of paper or fabric—or write the quote on the page yourself.
4. After making the project, read the text slip and uncover the picture.
