

basic supplies:











materials:

- · heavy white paper (large)
- · scissors, riler
- · protractors
- thin markers
- ·tape, pencils

reacher preparation:

- read TCR 687, and have in mind (or write a list of) the vivid descriptions of regeneration there
- · make sample
- · cut paper into strips, just under 2" wide, and 23" long

procedure:

- using protractors to get a 60° angle, fold paper strip into equilateral triangles (try to fold carefully)
- · you need 19 triangles ~ trim off entro
- · fold along fold lines in a spiral, up and down (now it will be 10 triangles long)
- ·lightly in pencil, number these 10 triangles (the single layer being "1")
- ·fold between triangles 2-3, triangles 5-6, and triangles 8-9 such that 2 \$3 fold away from each other, 5 \$ 6 fold
