

The Lord Makes All Things Grow

Just as the Lord causes flowers and trees to grow, so He causes us grow into people who can become angels in heaven. Make a picture to illustrate this idea.

Suggested Materials

paper crayons, markers, oil pastels, or colored pencils optional: glue, colored paper, and scissors

Procedure

- 1. Make a picture of the Lord.
- 2. Then draw a child sleeping nearby.
- 3. Now make a picture of a tree growing.
- 4. In the parable of the growing seed (Mark 4:26-27), a man sows the seed and while he is sleeping, the seed sprouts and grows. In a similar way, the Lord is helping us grow—physically and spiritually—and we are unaware of how He does it. When you look at this picture, think about all the Lord does for us "while we are sleeping or unaware."

Alternative Method

Use the scissors to cut out the shapes of the Lord, a sleeping child, and a tree. Glue these to the page and add details as desired with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
