

## The Lord's Church Is with Everyone...

The Lord's church is with all people in the world who live in good according to their religious principles. Illustrate this idea by making beautiful glass globes or Styrofoam balls to represent the earth.

### Making Glass Globes

#### Materials

clear glass ball ornament  
blue acrylic paint  
green acrylic paint  
gold or silver metallic marker



#### Procedure

1. Put some of the blue acrylic paint inside the ornament and swirl around.
2. Repeat with the green acrylic paint. This will suggest oceans and continents.
3. Use the gold or silver metallic marker to write a quotation on the outside of the globe such as:

*The Lord's church is with all who live in good.*

### Making Styrofoam Balls

#### Materials

styrofoam balls  
green and blue paint  
gold sequins  
straight pins or glue  
ribbon for hanging  
fancy paper

#### Procedure

1. Paint the entire styrofoam ball with blue paint. When it is dry, paint some areas with green paint to suggest continents.  
*Note:* Blue and green fabric could be glued to the Styrofoam ball instead of painting it.
2. Use push pins (or glue) to attach gold sequins on green areas of the ball to illustrate the idea that there are people of the Lord's church all over the world!
3. Write out a text slip on a piece of paper or ribbon and attach to the globe.

Short version of text slip (for wrapping around globe): *The Lord's church is with all who live in good.*

Longer version (to hang from bottom of globe): *The Lord's church is with all in the world who live in good according to their religious principles.*

4. Attach ribbon to the top of the ball so that it can be hung for display.
