basic supplies:



materials:

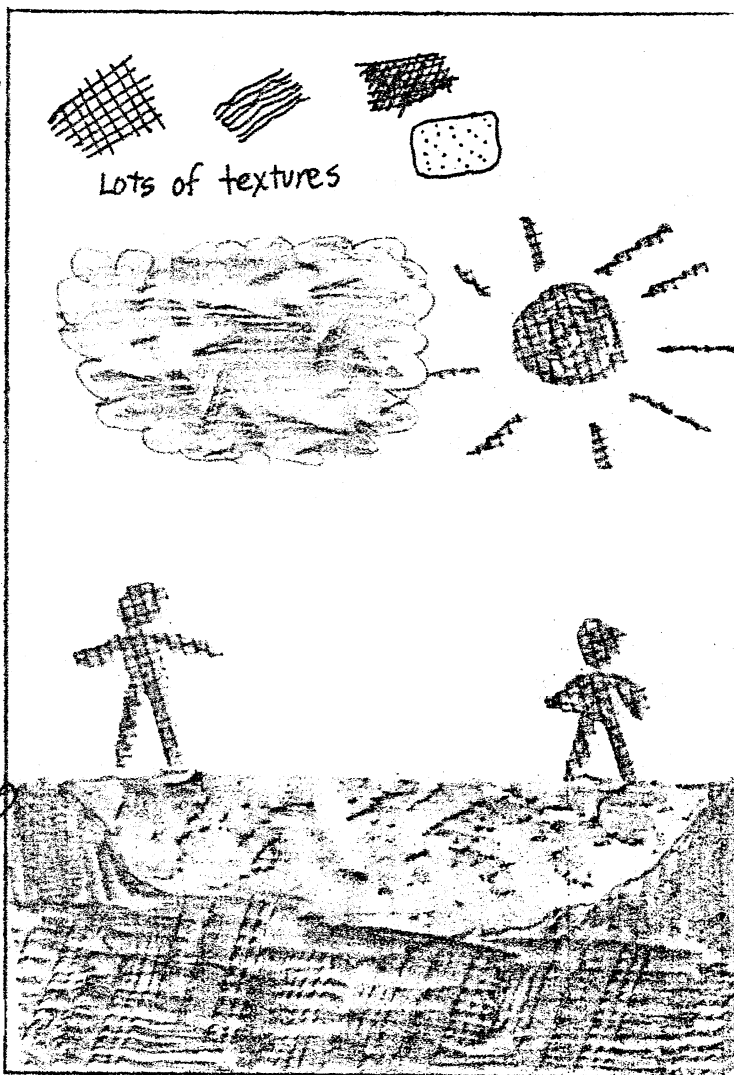
- lots of textured objects & materials (net, lace, basket, corrugated cardboard, burlap, buttons, crinkled aluminum foil, wood, etc.)
- newsprint or thin paper
- crayons, scissors, glue
- colored construction paper

teacher preparation:

- find lots of interesting textures for rubbing
- make sample
- peel crayons

procedure:

- with eyes closed, to imagine what it was like for the blind man, take crayon and make rubbings (on newsprint) of lots of textures (use side of crayon)
- pick crayons without peeking so color will be a surprise to you, too
- open eyes and guess what you rubbed!
- cut the rubbings into people, a pool, and scenery
- glue to colored paper
