basic supplies:



materials: newspapers, smocks

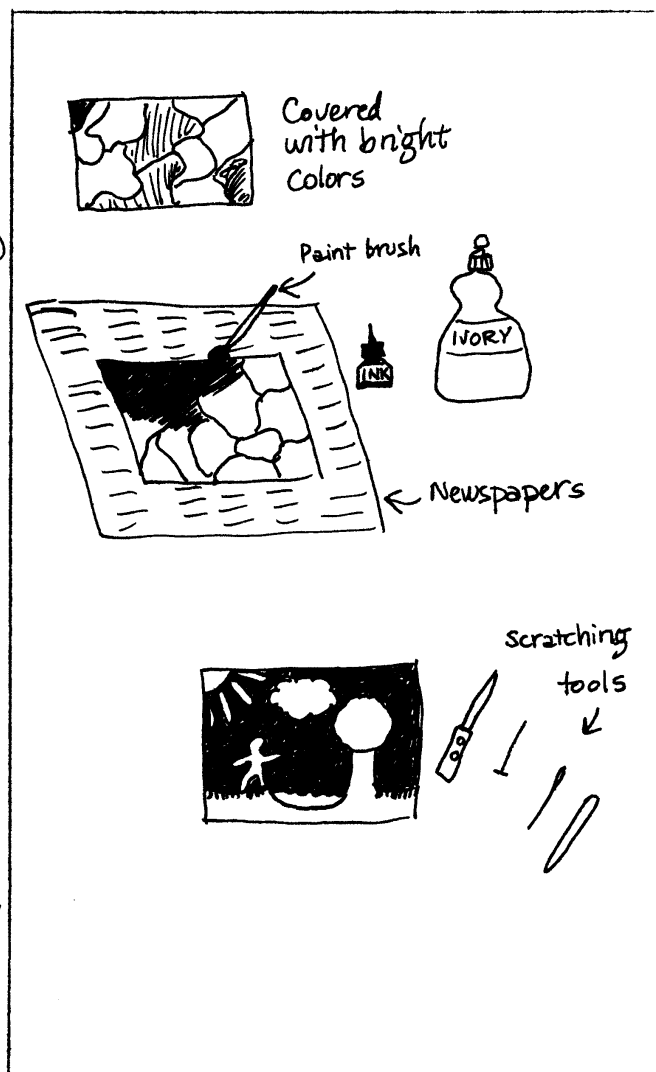
- posterboard or white cardboard
- craypas
- black ink and brush
- detergent (liquid)
- things to scratch with (nails, blunt end of large needle)

teacher preparation:

- make sample, but wait to scratch
- cut posterboard in pieces, of varying sizes (not too large)
- spread newspapers for inking

procedure:

- cover posterboard with bright, light colors (not black or brown) so that no spaces remain
- paint with ink mixed with a drop or two of detergent so it will adhere more easily to craypaped surface, let dry
- scratch a picture of some of the wonderful things the blind man may have seen when the LORD healed him



notes: give lesson while ink dries; talk about what it would be like to have the world change from darkness to colors!
