basic supplies:



materials:

- self hardening clay (or kiln-fired clay, if you have access to one) *
- newspapers
- smocks
- water, spray enamel

teacher preparation:


- make sample ~ let harden, and spray with enamel ~ fill to the brim with water for class
- have water in cups for dipping fingers to smooth clay
- spread newspapers

procedure:

- make a pinch pot or coil pot
- let harden
- talk about filling the "waterpots" of our minds to the very brim with truth
- spray next week, when dry

* or use Baker's clay:

4 C flour Mix, knead, shape,
1 C salt and bake 1 hr. 300°
1 1/2 C water then paint



notes: don't let them use too much water or clay will get soggy

- kiln-fired, or bisque, clay is less expensive ~ you could try to get a chunk from a local school
