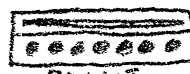
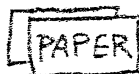
Text: John 11: 1-46

basic supplies:



PAINT

materials:

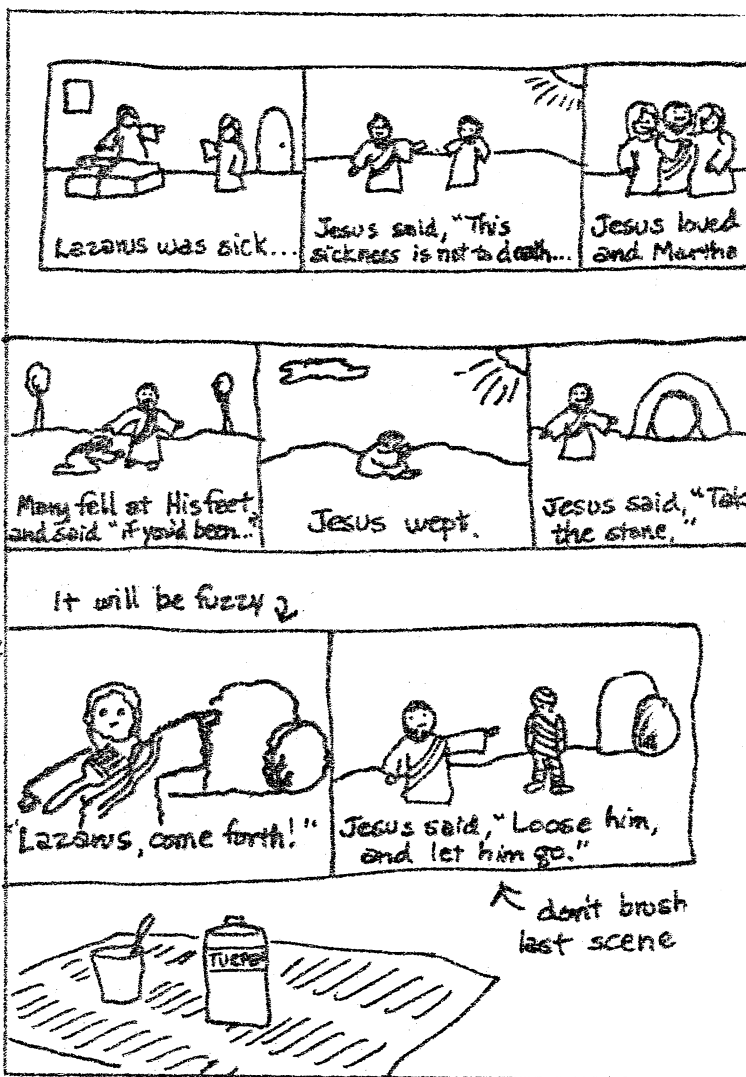
- plain sheet paper or other long paper
- crayons
- turpentine, brushes, old cans
- newspaper, smocks

teacher preparation:

- set up newspapers in well-ventilated area
- divide chapter into as many "scenes" as you have children
- divide paper into sections (one for each child / scene)

procedure: each child picks a scene

- with crayon, illustrate the story, (using plenty of crayon)
- write captions, paraphrased or from the WORD
- on newspapers, brush all of the scenes except when Lazarus "wakes up" with turpentine (on a brush)
- the pictures will look fuzzy ~ this is to show the contrast between the natural world and spiritual world ~ we will really see clearly when we wake up in heaven
