basic supplies:



materials: cigar or school boxes

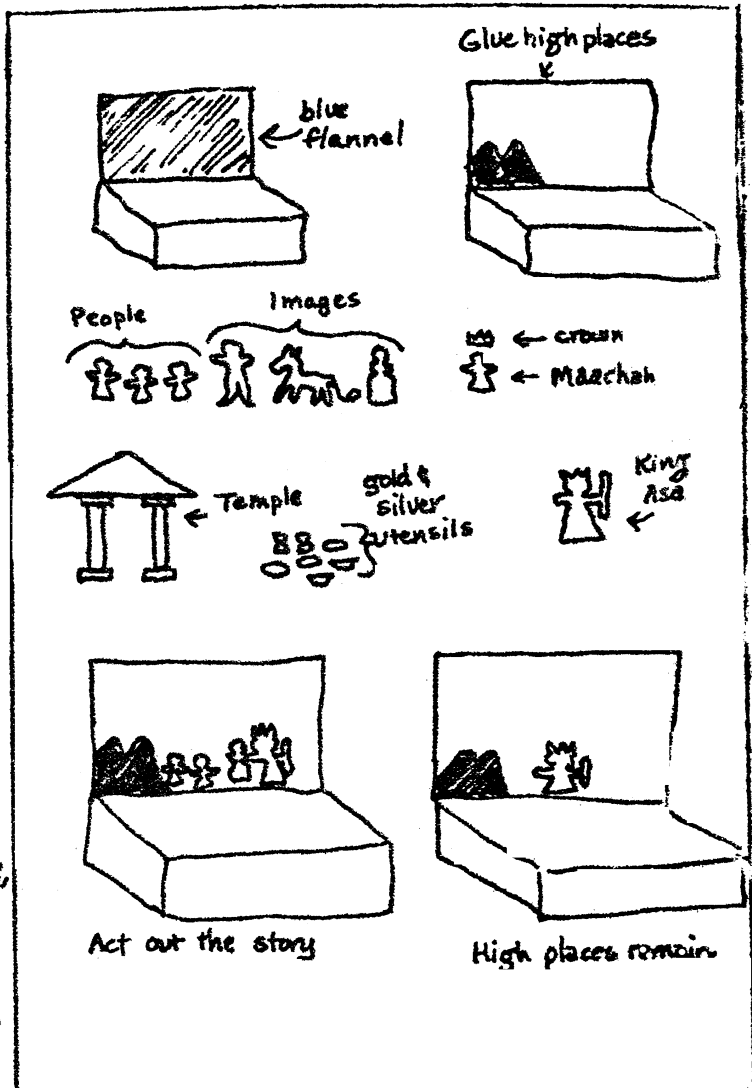
- light blue flannel
- felt
- scissors (good ones)
- glue
- contact paper, paint or wallpaper (optional)

teacher preparation:

- make sample
- perhaps have something for children to lean lids against as they act out the story

procedure:

- cut out and glue flannel to inside lid of box
- cut out and glue high places of brown or green felt
- cut out of felt: images, banished people, Maachah and her removable crown, image of Asherah, King Asa, (and if time allows) the temple and utensils
- act out the story, and talk about how the high places remained
- (optional) cover outside of box with paper or paint



notes: flannel boxes can be saved at Sunday School and used for other stories ~ store felt characters inside box
