Subject: The Tabernacle and the Ark

Age Group: Beginners: 3-5

basic supplies:      

### materials:

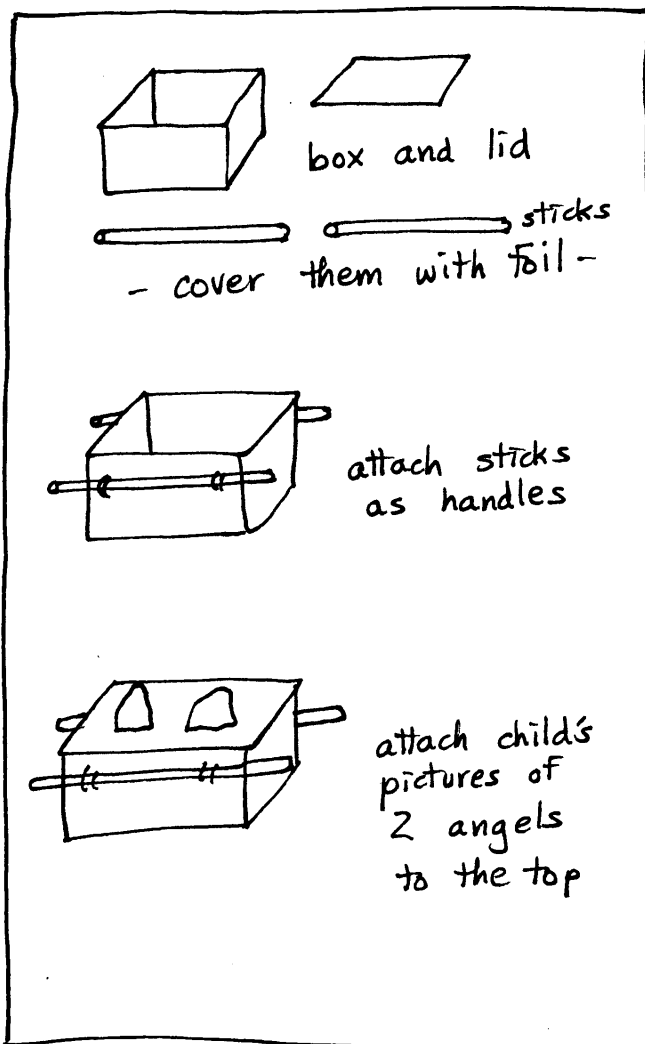
- lots of gold wrapping paper or lots of aluminum foil
- one cardboard box per child
- one dowel stick per child
- yellow construction paper

### teacher preparation:

- examine p. 145 in Dole's Notes to see the Ark
- cut boxes and reinforce pieces, so each child can have an open box and a removable flat lid
- cut dowel sticks in half

### procedure:

- wrap inside and outside with foil, using tape at edges.
- wrap removable lid with foil
- wrap sticks with foil
- attach sticks along sides of box
- let children draw what they think an angel looks like on yellow paper, then attach angels to lid, either standing, kneeling or lying (whatever is possible!).



notes: Ask children to put their Ten Commandment rocks inside
