Subject: The Tabernacle and the Ark

Age Group: Primary: 6-8

basic supplies:      

materials: glue

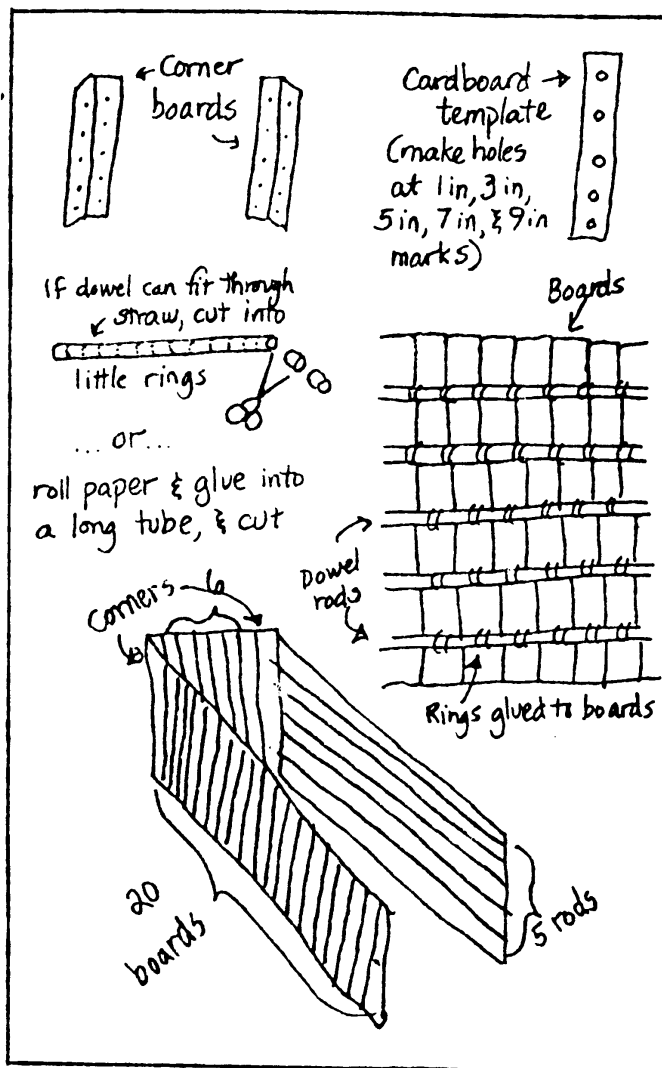
- balsa wood: 48 boards - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10"
- dowels 10-20" long; 5-10" long; 9-10" x $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- straws (if you can find ones big enough for the dowels to go through,) or stiff paper
- gold spray paint

teacher preparation:

- cut the wood to size
- cut 2 boards in half & glue to make the corner boards
- make cardboard templates with 5 evenly spaced holes for marking boards (where to put rings for poles)

procedure:

- mark boards with template
- cut straws and glue on marks, or make paper rings and glue on marks
- when dry, spray paint & let dry again
- insert poles & stand up!
- The 9 poles are to hold up veils, 4 on the inner room, 5 on the outer



notes: if you can't afford balsa, try heavy cardboard.
Talk about the bases & sockets, though they are left
out here. This project is meant to last 2 weeks for all
