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Text: Exodus 19:16-25, 20:1-21 **Subject: The Ten Commandments**


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Age Group: Beginners: 3-5

basic supplies: & MARKERS E











materials: For each child:

-2 Flat rocks, about 1/2 x 6 x 8

- bright paint, but no brushes

teacher preparation:

-collect rocks, using pairs of similarly shaped rocks

- put a bowl of bright paint at each child's place

procedure:

- Children differ in their abilities to draw letters and numbers, so vary your directions with each child:

Simple: Ask each child to put one finger in the paint and draw "10" on the rocks, to represent the Lord's finger writing the 10 Commandments.

Advanced: Putting one finger in the paint, draw 1 through 10 on the racks. Maybe even write the words "Ten Commandments."
