Subject: The Ten Commandments

Age Group: Beginners: 3-5

basic supplies:      

Materials: for each child:

- 2 Flat rocks, about $\frac{1}{2} \times 6 \times 8$
- bright paint, but no brushes

teacher preparation:

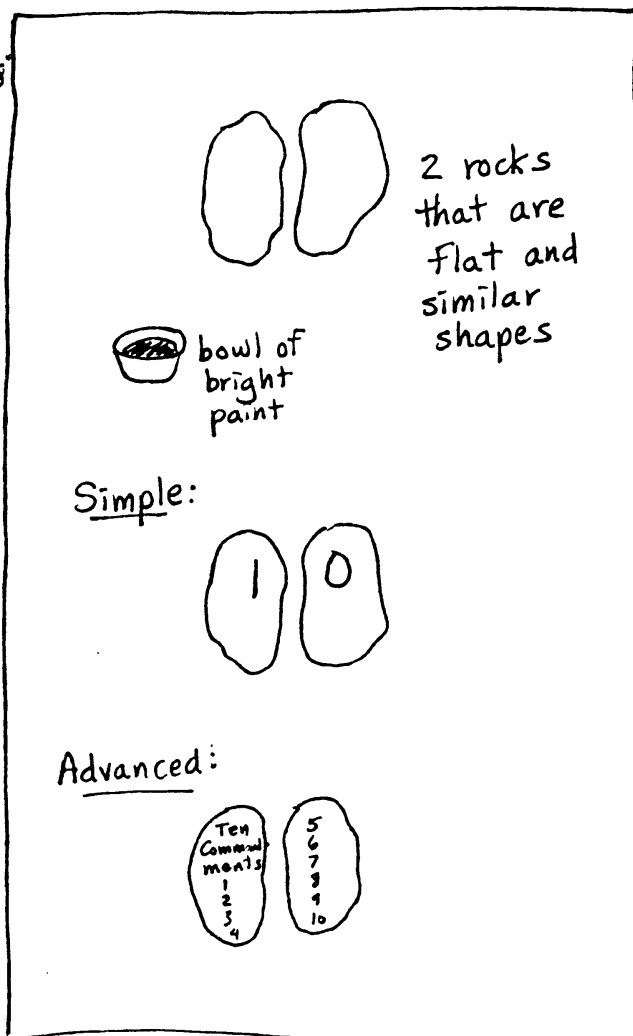
- collect rocks, using pairs of similarly shaped rocks
- put a bowl of bright paint at each child's place

procedure:

- Children differ in their abilities to draw letters and numbers, so vary your directions with each child:

Simple: Ask each child to put one finger in the paint and draw "10" on the rocks, to represent the Lord's finger writing the 10 Commandments.

Advanced: Putting one finger in the paint, draw 1 through 10 on the rocks. Maybe even write the words "Ten Commandments."



Notes: Bring extra rocks for kids to paint anyway they want after they finish carefully doing the Ten Commandments.
