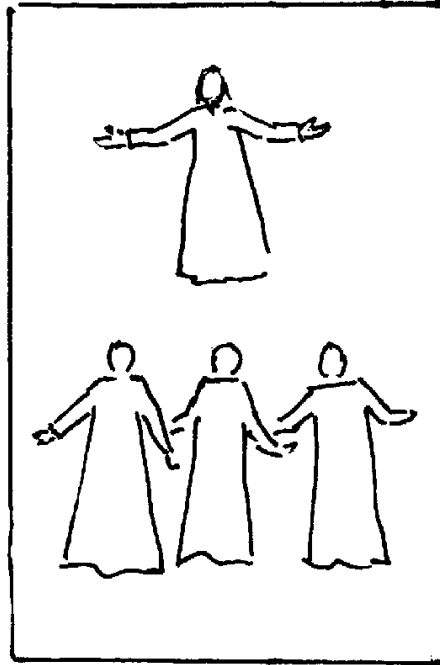


The Transfiguration

Matthew 17:1-8



Materials:

oil pastels (crayons, colored markers, or colored pencils could be used instead)
paper
optional: glitter

Procedure:

- 1) Talk with the children about the story. Tell them that when the Lord was transfigured, His face “shone like the sun and His clothes became as white as the light.”
- 2) Have the children draw the Lord as He appeared when He was transfigured. Show Peter, James, and John looking up at the Lord.
- 3) Optional: If desired, let the children use glitter (gold, silver, or shiny white) to indicate rays of light around the Lord.
